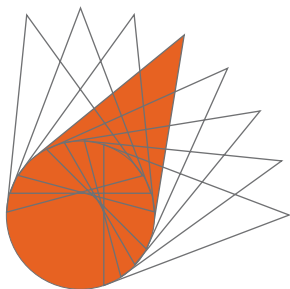

Experimental and numerical techniques will be discussed, such as wind tunnel research, full scale measurements and computational fluid dynamics techniques and applications. Topics include, but are not limited to:

- bluff body aerodynamics, including sports
- bridges and cables
- codification
- computational wind engineering
- field measurements
- pedestrian wind environment
- towers and chimneys
- ventilation
- wind energy
- wind effects on structures
- wind tunnel testing

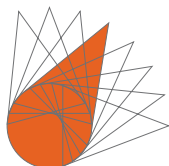
